Adolescent and Young Adult Hospice

Fugen Constructions completed construction on the Adolescent and Young Adult Hospice, Australia's first dedicated youth hospice for 15- to 24-year-old patients with life-limiting illness across New South Wales. The new, one-of-its-kind, two-storey facility includes eight bedrooms for patients, each with ensuite and balcony, two-family accommodation units with two bedrooms each, two carers' lounges, on-site kitchen and dining room, breakout spaces including lounge room, games room, media room, multisensory room, quiet room and sitting rooms, telehealth consult spaces and landscaped areas, including spaces for outdoor entertainment.





St George Hospital Stage 3 Perioperative Unit

Westmead Hospital Theatres 9-16

Fugen Constructions was engaged to deliver the refurbishment of Operating Theatres 9-16 as part of the Westmead Hospital Refurbishment (WHR) Stage 3 works for Health Infrastructure. The scope included the demolition of existing operating theatres, the reconstruction and fit-out of eight operating theatres—four of which became operational, while four remained warm shells for future completion. The works also encompassed upgrades and modifications to associated support areas to align with the new theatre layouts, and the conversion of an outdoor garden into a fully enclosed, staffroom for theatre staff.



Shoalhaven Community Preschool

Fugen Constructions was engaged to the deliver design finalisation and construction of the new Shoalhaven Community Preschool. As part of the enabling works for the \$438 million Shoalhaven Hospital redevelopment, the new facility was relocated to the southern end of the hospital campus. The project involved the construction of a new purpose-built early education centre that will accommodate up to 60 children, including up to 20 additional places, an external play area, landscaping, and a dedicated parking zone for carer drop-off.





Trinity Grammar School Temporary Villages 1, 2 and 3

Fugen was engaged to construct the the Temporary Village project for Trinity Grammar School as part of the enabling works for the Masterplan. The external works included timber decking, access ramps and stairs, seating steps, and a steel-framed roof structure for shade and weather protection.





Campbelltown Catholic Club Bistro

Established over 28 years ago, the bistro underwent a major revamp for the first time since it began operations. Completed over three stages to allow the club to continue its operations, the transformation features a baffle acoustic ceiling, custom floor tiling, a new and extended kitchen and servery, a main bar, a dedicated children's play area, and bespoke banquet-style joinery seating.





Parc Pavilion

Fugen Constructions was engaged by Feros Group to deliver the new Parc Pavilion within the Parc development in Cronulla - our sixth project for Feros. Designed by H&E Architects, the two-level fit-out included restaurants, bars, a premium gaming room, and a loggia opening onto an outdoor terrace. Works included a commercial kitchen and cool rooms on all levels, a refrigerated keg room, waste storage, utility rooms, an AV/comms room, and internal stairs. Amenities comprised male, female, and accessible bathrooms. A goods lift serviced the basement, ground, and level 1, with a patron lift linking the ground and upper levels.






The Hub, Hyde Park


