PROJECT OVERVIEW:

Fugen Constructions extended and refurbished the Prince of Wales Hospital Emergency Department across two stages. The first stage consisted of turning the existing outdoor courtyard area into an extension of the department with 9 new patient beds and associated facilities. Stage 2 works consisted of demolishing 10 existing patient beds and staff station and refurbishing the area which would be linked with Stage 1 on completion. This area consists of 6 new patient beds, staff station and sanitary facilities.

CHALLENGES:

All works were undertaken around a live operational hospital environment, with the operating Emergency Department and construction site separated by a hoarding.

SOLUTION:

Fugen restaged the project throughout the works to enable more hospital beds to be handed over at the completion of stage 1.

OVERALL OUTCOME:

The restaging was crucial in enabling Fugen to deliver the project 3 months ahead of the agreed completion date.
